

## **ABSTRACT**

**Fransisca Nathasia Wiria Hutagalung, Effect of Information Technology, Interdependence and Managerial Performance Against Broadscope Information (under the guidance of Mrs. Silvia Dewiyanti SE., Msi., Ak)**

This study aims to examine the influence of information technology, interdependence and broadscope information on managerial performance. The population in this study were the managers in the finance company in Palembang. This study sample was middle-level managers working in automobile finance company in Palembang with a purposive sampling technique. The data is returned and can be processed as many as 54 questionnaires. Analysis of the data used is multiple regression analysis. Techniques of data analysis in this study consisted of testing the quality of the data (validity and reliability testing), testing the assumption of classical (test for normality, multicollinearity test, test heterokedastisitas) and hypothesis testing. The results of this study indicate that (1) information technology does not affect the performance of manjerial (2) interdependence effect on managerial performance (3) information broadscope no effect on managerial performance.
