

ABSTRACT

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Factors related with juvenile delinquency in Senior Hih School Mardi Wacana Palembang

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Background: *Adolescent in their developmental stage tend to be emotional, start thinking abstract, difficult to control, behave rebellious and delinquent, seek identity, and try new things. Juvenile delinquency is a behavior that violates and is too far from the norms, limits of tolerance and rules that exist in society.*

Purpose: *Knowing to determine the factors associated with delinquency in Senior Hih School Mardi Wacana Palembang.*

Method: *This research use analytic survey method with cross sectional design done on 79 respondents and using sampling technique that is Total Sampling bivariate analysis technique used is Kendall's tau test with significant value.*

Result: *adolescent delinquency research result shows majority of juvenile delinquency of low category counted 53 respondents (67,1%). The social category shows the majority of the categories are less than 44 respondents (55.7%), the family roles show the majority of the high category as much as 50 respondents (63.3%) and the school environment shows the high majority of 43 respondents (54.4%). Kendall's test shows that there is a correlation between school environment and juvenile delinquency ($r = -0,235$ dan $p = 0,032$) and there is no correlation between socioeconomic with juvenile delinquency ($r = 0,054$ dan $p = 0,630$) and no relation between family role and juvenile delinquency ($r = -0,178$ dan $p = 0,107$). Recommended for schools to further improve discipline and teachers play an active role in adolescent development as well as for adolescents can minimize delinquency.*
